

ORDINANCE 17 – 2012
ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 104-29.1 (F)
OF THE WOODBURY HEIGHTS CODE

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to amend Section 104-29.1(F) of the Woodbury Heights Code to clarify the affiliation and qualifications of Traffic Directors;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, Gloucester County, New Jersey that Section 104-29.1(F) of the Woodbury Heights Code is hereby amended, in its entirety, as follows:

F. Traffic Directors. Traffic Directors shall be utilized at all construction or maintenance sites that may impair, impede or otherwise impact the safe and efficient movement of vehicles on public roadways as may be determined by the Woodbury Heights Police Department. In such cases, Traffic Directors shall be assigned by the Police Department with all such Directors to be regular Police Officers of the Woodbury Heights Police Department or such other regular Police Officers of other jurisdictions when approved by the Woodbury Heights Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED as follows:

- A.** If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by a Court to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective;
- B.** All Ordinances of the Borough of Woodbury Heights inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance be and are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
- C.** All Ordinances not inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby saved from repeal;
- D.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and publication and as otherwise provided by law.




NOTICE
