

RESOLUTION 110 - 2013

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY COMMODITY RESALE SYSTEM FOR THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AND RESALE OF GASOLINE, DIESEL FUEL, SNOW REMOVAL CHEMICALS AND PUBLIC WORKS MATERIALS

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.15 authorizes the establishment of a Commodity Resale System for the resale of certain commodities; and


WHEREAS, the County of Gloucester, acting as the "Lead Agency" for the establishment and conduct of a resale system which permits the participation by County Municipalities for the resale of gasoline, diesel fuel, snow removal chemicals and public works materials such as salt, asphalt and like materials permitted by the aforesaid authorizing provisions of the New Jersey Administrative Code has invited the participation of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights recognizes and understands that the Borough's purchase of such aforesaid goods and materials in this cooperative system will result in a municipal cost equal to the County's purchase cost plus an administrative service charge; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights is desirous of making use of the County's purchasing power and facilities for the purchase of these goods and materials which total cost is expected to be less than the municipality would pay individually for same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the Borough participate in the Gloucester County Commodity Resale System pursuant to the Cooperative Purchasing Rules aforesaid and that a true copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the County Purchasing Agent on behalf of the County of Gloucester as the lead agency for the purchase and resale of all goods and materials permitted by N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.1 et seq.


