

RESOLUTION 113 -2010

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT
FOR FIVE (5) NEW IN-CAR DIGITAL VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS
FOR THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights heretofore invited public bids for the acquisition, installation and delivery of five (5) new In-Car Digital Video Recording Systems and related equipment for the Woodbury Heights Police Department and received such bids on September 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Clerk received three (3) bid packages in advance of the bid opening conducted September 9, 2010 from the following bidders: Kustom Signals, Inc.; ICOP Digital, Inc.; and L-3 Communications Mobile-Vision, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Solicitor has thoroughly reviewed the aforementioned bids to ensure compliance with the bid documents and bid specifications required by the Borough of Woodbury Heights; and

WHEREAS, the bid documents submitted by Kustom Signals, Inc. were deemed by the Borough Solicitor to be deficient and non-compliant based upon the following:

1. The "*In-Car Digital Video Recording System Detailed Specifications*" completed by Kustom Signals, Inc. contained numerous exceptions and options that were not calculated to be included in the base bid submitted by Kustom Signals, Inc. as the sum of \$34,692.00;
2. Specifically, Paragraph 10 of the Detailed Specifications Checklist required an extended five (5) year on-site repair warranty that was listed as a option for an additional combined total of \$4,875.00;
3. Detailed Specification 13 required a minimum of eight (8) wireless microphones, however, the base bid included only five (5) wireless microphones with the additional three (3) microphones being provided as an option for the sum of \$888.00;
4. Detailed Specification 14 required simultaneous recording of the in-car microphone base station to charge and sync up to two (2) different microphones simultaneously, which was listed as an additional option to be purchased for a second docking station for each car as the combined sum of \$2,785.00;

5. Detailed Specification 19 required the back office/back end system to be compatible and connected by the successful bidder to the existing in-house file server to enable viewing of the video downloads from all desktop computer stations, however, the DEMM Playback Server was offered as an option for an additional sum of \$4,000.00;

6. Detailed Specification 21 required that the back office/back end system include a five (5) year on-site service and licensing agreement, however, the on-site maintenance agreement was provided as an optional upgrade at a cost ranging from \$15,000.00 up to the sum of \$40,000.00;

7. Detailed Specification 22 required that the back office/back end system be equipped with a back-up system capable of copying every media and/or video file to a DVD automatically (minimum 50 disc capacity), however, a DVD Archiver was listed as an additional optional upgrade as the sum of \$2,350.00;

8. The Detailed Specifications further provided that the new in-car digital video recording systems shall be installed by the successful bidder, however, installation was included as an option for a combined total of \$1,750.00, in addition to eight (8) hours of on-site training included as an option for the sum of \$1,537.00; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned options were not included in the base bid of \$34,692.00 submitted by Kustom Signals, Inc., which options total the minimum sum of \$33,185.00 for a combined bid sum of \$67,877.00 under the Detailed Specification Requirements outlined within the bid documents; and

WHEREAS, L-3 Communications Mobile-Vision, Inc. submitted a base bid of \$56,996.38 in excess of the bid proposal received from ICOP Digital, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, ICOP Digital, Inc. submitted a bid in conformance with the bid Specifications and bid documents referenced herein and the Solicitor has recommended acceptance of the bid proposal and base bid in the amount of \$40,748.14.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that for the above-referenced reasons, ICOP Digital, Inc. be and is hereby awarded a Contract for the above-referenced base bid proposal, subject to and conditioned upon the successful bidder's compliance with all other terms and conditions of the bid specifications and bid documents;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contract attached hereto; and




