

**RESOLUTION 131 - 2013**  
**RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE**  
**RECONSTRUCTION OF LAKE AVENUE-PHASE II**  
**PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has heretofore invited public bids for the Reconstruction of Lake Avenue-Phase II Project; and

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received and publically opened on October 22, 2013 consisting of two proposals; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposals invited and established by the bid documents consisted of a Base Bid together with multiple Alternate Bids; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough hereby intends to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder for Contract A and Alternate 1A for a total sum of \$123,517.98 and Contract B for the sum of \$38,018.15; and


**WHEREAS**, Cardinal Contracting Company, LLC has submitted the lowest bid for the above specified Base contract and Alternates for the sum of \$161,536.13; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer has recommended an award of contract to the said Cardinal Contracting Company, LLC and the Solicitor has reviewed and approved the proposal, bid bond and other submissions by Cardinal as consistent with the bid documents;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that Cardinal Contracting Company, LLC is hereby awarded a contract for all construction, work and materials specified in Contract A, Alternate 1A and Contract B of the bid documents in a total sum \$161,536.13 subject to the Borough's receipt of a Performance Bond in a form and sum consistent with the projects specifications;

**BY IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk is hereby authorized to return bid surety documents to the unsuccessful bidder forthwith after the adoption hereof.


