RESOLUTION APPOINTING REPRESENTATIVE TO THE "BUS TRANSPORT COMMITTEE" UNDER THE INTERLOCAL SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AND THE BOROUGH OF WENONAH


WHEREAS, Interlocal Service Agreements are authorized under and by virtue of the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:8A-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, in an effort to provide a more efficient transportation service for local residents, have previously adopted an Interlocal Services Agreement for the joint purchase and sharing of bus transportation services with the Borough of Wenonah; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Service Agreement provides that the Borough of Wenonah and the Borough of Woodbury Heights shall establish a "Bus Transport Committee", whereby the Borough of Woodbury Heights shall designate a representative to the aforesaid Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that Councilperson William Packer be and is hereby appointed as the Woodbury Heights Representative to the "Bus Transport Committee" for a term commencing immediately upon the adoption hereof and ending on December 31, 2011.


