

RESOLUTION 3 - 2015

RESOLUTION APPOINTING MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR AND ALTERNATE
MUNICIPAL PROSECUTORS FOR THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, the services of a Municipal Prosecutor and Alternate Municipal Prosecutors are required for the calendar year 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4(a) further permits appointments of Municipal Prosecutors and Alternate Municipal Prosecutors; and

WHEREAS, the below appointees are qualified under the Statute to serve in their respective positions; and

WHEREAS, these appointments are made pursuant to an "Open and Fair" process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council, with the Mayor concurring, as follows:

1. That, **Kelly Conroy, ESQUIRE**, be and is hereby appointed Municipal Prosecutor for the term retroactively commencing January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014;


2. That **John Alice, ESQUIRE** is hereby appointed alternate Municipal Prosecutor to serve in the absence or conflict of the Municipal Prosecutor of the Borough of Woodbury Heights for the term retroactively commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these appointments are awarded without competitive bidding as "Professional Services" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because said appointments encompass professional services recognized, licensed and regulated by law;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be published in the South Jersey Times within ten (10) days of its adoption.


