RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS
SHARED SERVICES WITH THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has launched its pioneering Public Archives and Records Infrastructure Support (PARIS) grant program to meet the strategic records management, preservation and storage needs of county and municipal governments; and

WHEREAS, a top priority of the PARIS grants program is to achieve efficiencies of cost and operation through shared services and to create a service structure for municipalities that do not have the resources to create one for themselves; and


WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights desires to collaborate with the County of Gloucester in the performance of Records Purging Reorganization and Inventory Expansion; and

WHEREAS, THE Borough of Woodbury Heights is acknowledging that the County of Gloucester would be both the lead agency and the applicant for such a proposal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that the Borough of Woodbury Heights does support and commit to cooperation and participation in the PARIS grant for the purposes set forth above, and to execute and deliver all documents required incident thereto.




