

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all objectors and owners of sites in the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan have received notice of the Petition; and



Friday, excluding holidays, for a period of forty-five (45) days following the date of publication of the legal notice pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:95-3.5.


