**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE GLOUCESTER

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Woodbury Heights intends to submit a proposal to the County of Gloucester for a Community Development Block Grant for a project attributable to fiscal year 2014; and






