

RESOLUTION 64- 2011
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OVERTIME RATE OF PAY FOR POLICE
PARTICIPATION IN THE "CLICK IT OR TICKET ENFORCEMENT"
GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Borough either has or is about to submit an Application for Grant Funding in the "Click it or Ticket" Enforcement Program administered by the Division of Highway Traffic Safety in the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, conditions of this program limit reimbursement for enforcement at an overtime rate of pay not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per hour for a total of 80 enforcement overtime hours; and


WHEREAS, the Borough has requested approval from the Collective Bargaining Unit for covered police officers to limit the overtime rate of pay for overtime duty assignments at the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that participation in the "Click it or Ticket" Grant Program, identified hereinabove, is hereby authorized at an overtime rate of pay for police officers not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per hour subject to approval of the Collective Bargaining Unit representing covered police officers;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Collective Bargaining Unit disapproves of the aforesaid limitation on the overtime rate of pay, the Police Department is then, and in such event, not authorized to participate in the grant program.


