**RESOLUTION TO AVERAGE TAX COLLECTION RATE**  
**FOR USE IN THE 2013 MUNICIPAL BUDGET**  
**RESOLUTION 64 -2013**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights experienced a decline in the tax collection rate for the year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the use of the lower collection rate in arriving at the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2013 Municipal Budget would result in an unfair tax burden to the taxpayers of the Borough of Woodbury Heights; and


WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs will allow the Borough of Woodbury Heights to use the average of the prior three years' collection rates in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2012 Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS, the prior three years' collection rates are 97.68% for 2009, 97.28% for 2010 and 96.50% for 2011; and


WHEREAS, the averaging of the prior three years' collection rates result in a collection rate of 97.15%;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Woodbury Heights will use the collection rate of 97.00% in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2013 Municipal Budget.


