

**RESOLUTION 67 - 2010
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION
TO THE GREEN ACRES PROGRAM TO
CONSTRUCT AN INDOOR RECREATION
BUILDING AT THE HELEN AVENUE SPORTS COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, a portion of the Helen Avenue Sports Complex area at Block 71, Lot 13; Block 72, Lot 2; Block 75, Lot 3 was acquired and developed as unfunded parkland under the Green Acres Program administered by the NJ Department of Environmental Protection under Project #0823-86-054; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has proposed construction of an indoor recreation building to consist of an indoor basketball court, concession area, storage and restroom facilities on a portion of unfunded but encumbered parkland on the border of Block 72, Lot 2 and Block 75, Lot 3; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has provided public notice of the aforesaid proposal and conducted a public hearing on May 19, 2010, all in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:36-25.6, et seq; and


WHEREAS, the Borough does hereby find and determine that the construction of the aforesaid indoor recreation facility will provide additional recreation opportunities for the youth of the Borough and will otherwise promote the public interest, health, safety and well-being and hereby approves of the change in use of the aforesaid land; and


WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection must approve this plan before the project may be implemented;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that application be made to the Green Acres Program of the Department of Environmental Protection for the aforesaid change in use of a portion of the unfunded parkland and that the proper borough officers do all other things necessary to seek such approvals and implement the project for construction of an indoor recreation facility on the property above identified;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Green Acres Program forthwith after the adoption hereof.


