

RESOLUTION 71 – 2012
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACTING
OF EMERGENCY REPAIR SERVICES AND MATERIALS
WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR
REPAIRS TO THE ROUTE 45 SEWER PUMP STATION

WHEREAS, an inspection of the Route 45 sewer pump station by the Public Works Director and Borough Engineer revealed that one of the component pumps was inoperable and the remaining pump is leaking and exhibiting characteristics consistent with a possible failure of operation; and

WHEREAS, this sewer pump station receives sanitary sewage flows from a substantial region of improved business properties along Route 45 and its continued operation is necessary to avoid a risk to the public health, safety and welfare since the failure of the remaining pump and other components could represent a catastrophic environmental and public health hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has determined and certified that an emergency exists and that immediate repairs and replacements to station components is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and


WHEREAS, the current condition of the pump station was unforeseen and was only discovered during a routine inspection; and

WHEREAS, the "Local Public Contracts Law" (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq) requires that contracts for the provisions of goods, services and materials be subject to public, competitive bidding except those contracts which constitute an emergency as set forth within N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6; and


WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby finds and determines that an emergency existed requiring immediate repairs to the aforesaid pump station and that the delay in awarding contracts or the purchase of materials to accomplish the repairs, if advertised in a public bidding process, would constitute a risk to the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that a Contract for emergency repairs to the Route 45 sewer pump station, located on or about Block 5, Lot 5.03 is hereby authorized and ratified without public advertisement for bids pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:A11-6.


