

**RESOLUTION 77 - 2010
RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT
FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF
WEST JERSEY AVENUE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2010 the Borough opened sealed bids submitted for the reconstruction of West Jersey Avenue Project; and

WHEREAS, among the seven Bid Proposals submitted is a bid of American Asphalt Co., Inc. which is determined to be the lowest bidder with a proposal of \$67,817.30 for the Base Bid and \$25,414.50 for the Alternate Bid for a total of \$93,231.80 for both proposals; and


WHEREAS, the Engineer has reviewed the Proposals submitted and determined American Asphalt Co., Inc. as the lowest responsible Bidder and recommends the acceptance of its proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Solicitor has reviewed the submissions by the aforesaid American Asphalt Co., Inc. and determined same to be consistent with the Bid Specifications and requirements of New Jersey Law as a "Fair and Open Bid";

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the Bids of American Asphalt Co., Inc. for both the Base Bid and Alternate Bid, together totaling \$93,231.80, are hereby accepted and the proper Officers of the Borough authorized to sign a Contract and all other documents required or convenient to accomplish this project award subject to the Bidder complying with all other terms and conditions of the Bid Document;




