

RESOLUTION 78-2010

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING VENDOR
SERVICES FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT**

WHEREAS, the Deputy Court Administrator has resigned and the Borough has no present intent to fill such vacancy by reason of budget constraints; and

WHEREAS, the Court will, from time to time, require the services an Acting Deputy Court Administrator on occasions of the vacation or unavailability of the Court Administrator and will also require a person to handle the duties of a Violations Clerk during sessions of the Court; and


WHEREAS, the Municipal Judge has authority to appoint such person or persons necessary to accomplish the duties of the Court and the Borough finds and determines that the services of qualified vendors represents an economical and efficient means by which to provide staffing for the Court; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that appropriate fees for a vendor acting as a Deputy Court Administrator is at a rate of \$20 per day and fees for vendors acting as a Violations Clerk is \$70 per court session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights with the Mayor concurring, that the Municipal Court is authorized to engage the services of outside vendors to perform, on as-needed basis, services of an Acting Deputy Court Administrator and Violations Clerk at the flat rates of compensation hereinabove recited.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be filed with the Municipal Court forthwith after the adoption hereof.
