

**RESOLUTION 94 - 2013**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION WITH THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER IN AN URBAN COUNTY COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ENTITLEMENTS AND HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUNDS**


**WHEREAS**, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, commonly known as the "Community Development Block Grant Program" (sometimes "CDBG Program") provides Federal funds to be granted to certain urban counties;

**WHEREAS**, together with twenty-three municipalities in Gloucester County, the Borough deems it in its best interests to enter into a Cooperation Agreement to participate in the above Programs, such Agreement annexed hereto and titled "Urban County Qualification Cooperation Agreement with Eligible Units of Local Government for the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement and Home Investment Partnership Program Funds";


**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid Cooperation Agreement shall automatically renew for participation in these Programs for successive, three year periods unless either the County or the participating municipalities provide written notice to the Department of Housing and Urban Development that it elects not to participate in a new qualification period;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes participation in the Urban County Qualification Cooperation Agreement with Eligible Units of Local Government for the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement and Home Investment Partnership Program Funds", and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and deliver the aforesaid annexed Agreement to the Administrative Officer of the County of Gloucester forthwith after the adoption hereof.


