ORDINANCE NO. 16-2010

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 12-2009 OF THE
BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS, IN THE COUNTY
OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 of Bond Ordinance 12-2009 ("Bond Ordinance"), is hereby amended to provide as follows:



B.	Constructions of a Recreational Building including, but not limited to, the replacement and renovation of exterior walls, roof and roofing, overhead doors, insulation, HVAC system, plumbing and electric, as well as the completion of two accessible toilet rooms, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto	1,116,000	53,150	1,062,850	25 years

Section 2. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended applicable capital budget and applicable capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 3. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.


STATEMENT
