


ORDINANCE 5 - 2010
ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 27-16 OF THE WOODBURY HEIGHTS
CODE RELATING TO OFF-DUTY POLICE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that off-duty police services are requested through other police jurisdictions and the Borough, like other jurisdictions, is desirous of permitting members of the Police Department to perform such services in other jurisdictions subject to approval of the Chief of Police;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that Section 27-16 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Members of the Woodbury Heights Police Department are hereby authorized and empowered to perform off-duty police-related services for private persons or entities during off-duty hours in other police jurisdictions when approved by the Chief of Police;
2. Rates for payment of officers engaged in such off-duty assignments shall be that rate of payment established by Ordinance in the outside jurisdiction;
3. All other terms and provisions of Section 27-16 of the Code, to the extent not amended hereby, are hereby saved from repeal;
4. All terms and provisions of Section 27-16 of the Code inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed;
5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, publication and as otherwise provided by law.




