

ORDINANCE 9- 2011
ORDINANCE PROHIBITING COMPENSATORY LEAVE

WHEREAS, by reason of the modest size of the Borough work force the Borough has heretofore approved Compensatory Leave (time off) to employees in lieu of overtime pay; and

WHEREAS, the Borough deems it in its best interests to prohibit such Compensatory Leave since the absence of employees entitled to such leave negatively impacts the administration of the business of the Borough and, therefore, the Borough desires to prohibit use of Compensatory Leave as compensation for employees except members of the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that Section 23-9(B) of the Woodbury Heights Code is hereby repealed and, in its place and stead, enact the following:

§23-9(B) except for Members of the Police Department, the use of compensatory leave time to compensate employees for work in excess of regular hours or for any other purpose whatsoever is hereby prohibited.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all non-police employees who have accrued compensatory leave time shall be offered the option to be paid for such accrued compensatory leave time in such sums as the Borough and each employee shall mutually determine and agree.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED as follows:

A. All existing Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency;

B. All existing Ordinances of the Borough not inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and are hereby saved from repeal;

C. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication and as otherwise provided by law.




