Moline as Chief of Police of the Borough of Woodbury Heights Police Department effective as of June 20, 2018; and subject to the terms and conditions of all applicable Borough Personnel Policies, Employee Handbook and Borough Ordinances that pertain to the position of Chief of Police; and
