NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Agent of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, and publicly opened and read in the Municipal Building, 500 Elm Avenue, Woodbury Heights, New Jersey, 08097, on Friday, October 5, 2018, 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, for the following:

NEW FIRE PUMPER

This Contract will be awarded using the competitive contracting provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.40A:11-1, et seq. Complete specifications, instructions to bidders, invitation to bidders and other pertinent information and materials are on file in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough of Woodbury Heights at the Borough Hall located at 500 Elm Avenue, Woodbury Heights, New Jersey 08097, and may be inspected and/or received by prospective bidders during regular business hours. Bids must be in accordance with the form of proposal prescribed in the manner designated, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder on the outside thereof, and addressed to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Woodbury Heights and clearly marked "BID-FIRE PUMPER". All bid forms must be accompanied by a complete set of the bid specifications completely filled out as set forth therein. All bids must be delivered to the Borough Clerk at the Borough Hall, 500 Elm Avenue, Woodbury Heights, New Jersey, 08097, on or before the date and hour hereinabove stated. This bid proposal constitutes an invitation to submit bids to the Borough, however, the Borough reserves the right to waive any technical error; to reject any proposal; or any part thereof for any reason whatsoever or to reject all proposals for any reason whatsoever. Specifically, the

Borough reserves the right to reject all bids without cause. The Borough shall not be responsible for the loss, non-delivery or physical condition of bid proposals sent by mail or courier service.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond duly executed by the bidder as principal and having as surety thereon, a surety company approved by the Borough of Woodbury Heights in an amount not less than ten (10%) percent of the sum bid, but in no case in excess of Twenty-Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars of the amount bid. Any such bid bond shall be without endorsement or conditions. The bid shall also be accompanied by a certificate letter from a surety company stating that it will provide the bidder with the completion bond.

All bids must be accompanied by a fully-signed Non-Collusion Affidavit.

Prospective bidders are further notified that they must comply with P.L. 1977, Chapter 33, and submit a Disclosure Statement listing the names and address of all owners and/or stockholders of the corporate entity and/or partnership who own ten (10%) percent or more of its stock or any class or all individual partners of a partnership who own ten (10%) percent or more thereof. Bidders are further required to comply with the requirements of the New Jersey Public Works Contractor Registration Act. Failure to supply this information with the form of proposal will be sufficient cause to reject the bid.

All bidders are further required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31, et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, against discrimination on the basis of race, religion, sex, national origin, creed, color, ancestry, age, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or familial status. It shall be the obligation of the bidder to complete the Disclosure Statement indicating that there will be compliance with the Affirmative Action requirements of the State of New Jersey.

Prospective bidders are further notified that all bids shall comply with the requirements of the New Jersey Business Registration Act, P.L. 2004, c. 57 and submit proof of business registration of the primary contractor and each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used. Failure to submit proof of business registration with the bid and form of proposal shall be sufficient cause to reject the bid.

If awarded a contract, your company/firm shall be required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31, et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

The Borough of Woodbury Heights assumes no responsibility for bids returned by mail or delivered after the deadline for submission of bids, referenced above. The Borough further expressly reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any minor informalities or irregularities in the proposals received and to accept the bids which is in the best interest of the Borough of Woodbury Heights. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder complying with the bid requirements and specifications pursuant to the "New Jersey Public Contracts Law".

No proposal shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days subsequent to the date of receipt of the bid proposal without the consent of the Borough. The award of a Contract shall be subject to the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds in the 2018 Fiscal Year Budget. Should sufficient funds not be made available in the Fiscal Year 2018 Permanent Operating or Capital Budget, a Contract will not be made.
