

RESOLUITON 96-2018

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH
SHAFTS AND SLEEVES, INC OF BORDENTOWN, NJ FOR REPAIRS TO
ROUTE 45 SEWER PUMP STATION**

WHEREAS, The Borough of Woodbury Heights has a sewer pump station located on Route 45 between Holly and Lincoln Avenues; and

WHEREAS, the pump station filled with ground water on September 7, 2018 which caused damage to the station resulting in its inability to be run; and

WHEREAS, the failure to the station and the threat of contamination resulting therefrom posed a significant and immediate threat to the health, safety and welfare of people in the immediate vicinity as well as to the surrounding environment, necessitating immediate repairs; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.40A:11-6 allows a municipality to award a contract on an emergency basis without public advertising for bids and bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's licensed operator has certified that an emergency condition existed and has recommend that the Borough authorize/ratify the execution of emergency contract to pay for the immediate repairs that had to be made to the sewer pump station; and

WHEREAS, Shafts and Sleeves, Inc of Bordentown, NJ , has and will continue to provide the necessary repairs needed to correct the problems at a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00 for 2018; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this emergency contract and a certification of availability of funds has been provided by the Borough Chief Financial Officer from Account 8-09-55-502-000-256 by Victoria Holmstrom; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 19th day of September, 2018, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that:

A contract shall be and are hereby authorized and ratified with Shafts and Sleeves, Inc for the work associated with the Route 45 Station flooding:

1. This contract is awarded for a total amount not to exceed \$25,000, which shall be charged to Account 8-09-55-502-000-256.
2. This contract is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, which allows a municipality to award contracts on an emergency basis without public advertising for bids and bidding.




CERTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS
