WHEREAS, bids for this road project were advertised pursuant to Section 4 of P.L. 1971, c.198 (C), [N.J.S.A.40A:11-4] and publicly opened by the Township Engineer and Borough Administrator on May 14, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Borough received five (5) bid proposals from Landberg Construction, LLC (\$528,369.12); South State, Inc. (\$617,370.75); R.E. Pierson Construction Co., Inc. (\$725,838.55); Ricky Slade Construction, Inc.(\$603,516.50); and Perna Finnigan, Inc.(\$497,734.29) on May 14, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The Township Engineer has reviewed the bid proposals and has recommended the award of the Contract to Perna Finnigan, Inc. for the 2018 Academy Avenue & Lake Avenue Roadway Improvements Project as the lowest responsible bidder based on the following comprehensive proposal submitted by Perna Finnigan, Inc. NJDOT Work: \$233,694.50; Borough Utility Work: \$264,039.79 for a Total Project Amount: \$497,734.29; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the aforesaid Perna Finnigan, Inc. is in substantial compliance with the bid instructions and specifications generated by the Borough; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the 2018 Academy Avenue & Lake Avenue Roadway Improvements Project is hereby awarded to Perna Finnigan, Inc.in the following amounts which shall not be exceeded: NJDOT Work: \$233,694.50; Borough Utility Work: \$264,039.79 for a Total Project Amount: \$497,734.29, subject to and conditioned upon the provisions of performance surety and further compliance with the bid documents and specifications by Perna Finnigan, Inc. including verification of funds by the Borough CFO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to return all bid surety to all unsuccessful bidders forthwith after the adoption hereof.
