RESOLUTION 99-2019

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF A SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE BUDGET OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 (CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, hereby requests that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget year 2019 in the sum of \$1,948.04 which item is now available as a revenue from Division of Justice Body Armor Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a like sum of \$1,948.04 be and the same is hereby appropriated under the caption of: **Division of Justice Body Armor Fund**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above is the result of a grant awarded by the United States Department of Justice.




